Social Determinants of Health Improvement Action Network

High readmission rates are frequently a result of social determinants of health (SDoH), and to address this challenge IHA is kicking off an Improvement Action Network (IAN) in the first quarter of 2020. Over a ten week period, participants will receive intensive coaching and feedback on a step-by-step approach to implementing SDoH screening in their emergency department.

Key program dates are:

- January 16: Kick-off webinar
- January 30: Shared learning call
- February 11: In-person regional workshop (videoconference between Naperville and Springfield)
- February 27: Shared learning call
- March 12: Shared learning call
- March 26: Wrap-up webinar

All webinars will be held from 9:30-10:30 a.m. The in-person regional workshop will be from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Falls Webinar Series – Register Today!

Each year, millions of older adults fall, and over 800,000 patients a year are hospitalized as a result of a fall injury. From 2007 to 2016, fall death rates among adults age 65 and older have increased more than 30%. The rising number of deaths from falls in older adults can be addressed by screening and intervening to address fall risk factors.

During this webinar series participants will learn from expert Pat Quigley about the implementation science of fall injury programs, post-fall management strategies and innovation in fall and fall injury prevention.
