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Data Platform Roll-Out: We Need To Hear From You!

We are under way with conferring accounts to hospitals to access our updated HIIN reports. By now, everyone has received either an email from CompDATA with steps to create your account and/or an email from Brigitte with a link to a short survey.

Once you complete the survey sent by Brigitte, you will receive the CompDATA account initiation email that you must respond to in order to finalize your account credentials.

The Institute HIIN team is currently working with our IHA Informatics team to expand our server capacity to accommodate these requests.

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Data Submission to the KDS

Please log into the KDS and check on the status of your PFE metrics, especially #4 and #5.

We need all hospitals to update their PFE data. These do not automatically update, nor will you be prompted to update them. We believe our current data does not reflect the progress many of you have made.

Please remember submit your data MONTHLY for the three adverse drug events and falls!

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CIC, CPHQ, and CPPS Update

Hospitals may elect to certify more than one person per hospital in 2018. Please feel free to contact [Brigette](#) if you have questions about obtaining a certification.

- CIC: The IHA will pay for the CIC (Certification in Infection Prevention and Control) offered by the Certification Board of Infection Control and Epidemiology (CBIC). We will be able to pay for the exam fees associated with obtaining this certification and the APIC Certification Study Guide if your Infection Control Nurses would like to take advantage of this opportunity. There is no need to register for this certification, just have your Infection Control Nurse send us a reimbursement form for the cost of the exam/study guide (along with the receipt).

- CPHQ: Each HIIN hospital has the opportunity to nominate someone from their organization to earn the only accredited certification in the field of healthcare quality, the Certified Professional in Healthcare Quality (CPHQ). The CPHQ package being offered through the HIIN consists of access to the Q Solutions Books, the practice exam, and covers the cost of sitting for the exam. Set yourself up for success in advancing the profession by earning the CPHQ and demonstrate your competence in healthcare quality, distinguish yourself from other healthcare quality professionals, enhance your credibility, demonstrate your dedication to the field, and show your preparedness to improve outcomes across the continuum of care.
