Submit Your 2019 Innovation Challenge Application

Applications are now being accepted for the 2019 IHA HIIN Innovation Challenge – Partners in Progress. All participating IHA HIIN Hospitals are encouraged to submit their applications via the [application portal](#). Please refer to our [Application guidelines](#) to help plan your submission.

- Three prizes of \$10,000 will be awarded to hospitals who can demonstrate at least a 20% reduction in HIIN harm attributable to an innovative solution. Hospitals may submit a maximum of three applications.
- Recipient organizations will receive 12 months of assistance from IHA HIIN staff to optimize the innovation within their organization.
- Challenge winners will be tasked with spreading their innovation to an adoption-ready peer, with the assistance and support of IHA HIIN staff.

All Innovation Challenge applications are due by Friday, November 16 at Noon.
