ALTO Project Cohort 2 Recruitment Webinar

After the tremendous success of its first cohort, the MHA Keystone Center, in conjunction with the GLPP HIIN, will soon launch the second cohort of its opioid safety initiative for emergency department (ED) teams.

The project will replicate the Alternative to Opioids (ALTO) program, which initially launched in Colorado and successfully reduced the administration of opioids in Emergency Departments (EDs). The MHA Keystone Center will host two recruitment webinars – [July 23](#) and [Aug. 21](#) - to discuss the program requirements and overall framework. The content of both ALTO webinars are identical, so members can choose the date that is most convenient.
