Communication - Continued

- Collaboration with Speech
 Language Pathologists
 - Increased use of Passy Muir Valve on tracheostomy patients
 - Communication sheet completed by RT on those patients who have tracheostomy or intubated for >72hrs.

VAE Prevention

- Oral Care
 - Initially, RN responsibility
 - Changed this to a shared responsibility with RT which increases communication
- ETT re-position Q2
 - Documented with ventilator checks
 - Shared responsibility between RT/RN which increases communication

VAE Prevention – cont.

- HOB $\geq 30^{\circ}$
 - Audited
- Communication with SLP's
 - More PMV trials for tracheostomy patients
- Extubation Readiness Test (ERT)

Extubation Readiness Test (ERT)

- ERT initiated by intensivists
 - Prior extubation was based on ABG results
 - Currently based on ERT/ABG's/pulmonary mechanics

- Bedside bronchoscopy initiated
 - RT assists intensivist
 - Immediate pulmonary needs recognized and treated
- Transport/MRI ventilator initiated
 - Consistent ventilation provided during transport/testing
- Aerogen initiated
 - Less ventilator circuit disconnects
 - Better deposition of medication

What else have we done?

- Respiratory Educator established
 - New Hire Orientation improvements
 - Education for RT's and additional departments
- Airway Team (in progress)
 - More tracheostomy education for increase in that patient population
 - New policies / procedures
 - Communication with staff / increased awareness


